PRACTICE TEAM:

The practice is continuing to assess the demand versus capacity.

The list size has grown significantly over the past month and is of today 13,475

Our new GPST2 has commenced in Post – Dr Gusbi

Our PCN Nurse Katie Smith is working within the 3 practices in Darwen and assisting in catch up priorities such as Smears, Immunisations and Hypertension Reviews.

Spirometry Clinics recommenced some months ago and continue to be completed with a final catch up clinic on Saturday 18 March 23

PRACTICE TELEPHONY SYSTEM:

Patient feedback has mainly been very positive in terms of lesser waiting times on the phone average waiting time is just over 2 Mins and 45 Secs. There are periods each day when the phones are quiet and this is allowing workstreams to be delegated in contacting patients who have failed to attend booked appointments.

Failed to attend data for the past 3 Months is as follows:
